



Help is on our Website

If you need assistance in understanding and using State Library resources, you can always contact our Reference staff. However, the Library also provides numerous help features that you should take a look at on the State Library website.

Start by going to our **State Employee Resources** page <http://library.ohio.gov/Marketing/StateEmps>. Look for **Library Training Resources & Events** under Links and click on it. Here is some of what you will find:

Training Calendar – gives you an actual calendar of the upcoming schedule of training events, both here in our Training Room and online as **webinars**. Click on **Training Calendar** to see the one for this month and those for upcoming months. **Note:** by using the drop-down box under **Events**, you can set the calendar to show only those meant for state employees.

Click on the **title** of each event for details and to get the online form for signing up to participate. **Note** that the **WebEx software** necessary for participating in our webinars must be downloaded to your computer. The link and instructions for this are provided.

Ten Minute Tutors – Quick instructions on using our services that you can view and listen to at your own pace. They are made up of slides and a voice-over. **Note:** if you wish to view a tutorial **without the sound**, use the little speaker on the left side of the bottom of the screen to turn it off. You can view what the voice is saying by clicking on **Notes** on the left side of the screen.

Electronic Resources Help – Tells you how to access the many electronic sources found on the State Library website and gives you tips for using them. Some examples are: NetLibrary eBooks, Ohio Newspapers, OhioLINK's Electronic Journal Center, and the Serial Set from LexisNexis. You may want to print these out.

Subject Guides – provides specific source links for 39 subjects. Electronic Collections links to databases with good coverage of your topic, and eJournals/eBooks shows you some online full-text journals and eBooks. Links to websites on your topic are next, followed by titles of print books in the State Library and/or OhioLINK collections, library call numbers and terms to use in catalog searching. You may also want to print out the Subject Guide(s) of interest to you.
