

Academic Search Complete (EBSCO): the world's most comprehensive scholarly, multi-disciplinary full text database, with more than 5,300 full-text periodicals, including 4,400 peer-reviewed journals. In addition to full text, this database offers indexing and abstracts for more than 9,300 journals and a total of 10,900 publications including monographs, reports, conference proceedings, etc.





Electronic Journal Center (EJC): Includes the full text of more than 7000 online research journals covering many subject areas.


